WELCOME TO BETHEL CHURCH! This morning, Pastor Rick shifts gears from preaching about THE EXODUS in order to prepare for his Sabbatical Exodus. Pastor Rick has chosen that familiar passage from 1 Corinthians 12 and the Body of Christ to reflect on the nature of the church as the Body of Christ, and how each one of us are called to BE the church.

During the 5pm afternoon worship we will look at one more hymn story based on Psalm 42. It is actually more of a contemporary song story, which may not be as dramatic as some others we have reviewed, but it still has important implications for how we look at scripture and sing our faith.

The bread and juice we see are symbols of his body and blood and signs and seals of his gospel promise that our forgiveness and hope is found in the sacrifice of Jesus. May God use this gift he has given through his Son Jesus to affirm our faith and draw us closer to him. If you have publicly confessed Jesus as your Savior and Lord, are sorry for sin and desire to live for him, we invite you to join with us and participate in communion.

This morning **Katlyn Eenigenburg** will make a public profession of faith in Jesus as her Savior and Lord. And **Bailee Jansma** will join the church as she makes a reaffirmation of her faith in Jesus! Praise God from whom all blessings flow! We thank the Lord for his Spirit's work in their lives!
