## Philippians 3:1-11 IMPRESSING GOD

1. Many people have tried to make an impression on God by his own <u>efforts</u>. (vs 4-6)

a. Pharisees

b. Martin Luther

c. Paul

2. Paul discovered that all his achievements were mere garbage. (v. 8)

3. Only the <u>righteousness</u> of Jesus Christ is enough to satisfy a holy God. This righteousness becomes ours only through <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ. (v. 9)

## Jonah 3 THE GLORY OF A SECOND CHANCE

1. Take advantage of God's second chance. (vs. 1-2)

2. When you hear the Word of God, you had better do it. <u>Obedience</u> is the key! (v. 3)

3. The preacher has no right to <u>proclaim</u> his own message. The authority of preaching comes from declaring the <u>Word of God.</u> (v. 4)

4. There is nothing wrong with <u>changing</u> your mind, when it is for the <u>right</u> reason.

- a. <u>Jonah</u> changed his mind. (v. 3)
- b. <u>Nineveh</u> changed its mind. (vs. 5-9)
- c. <u>God</u> changed his mind. (v. 10)
