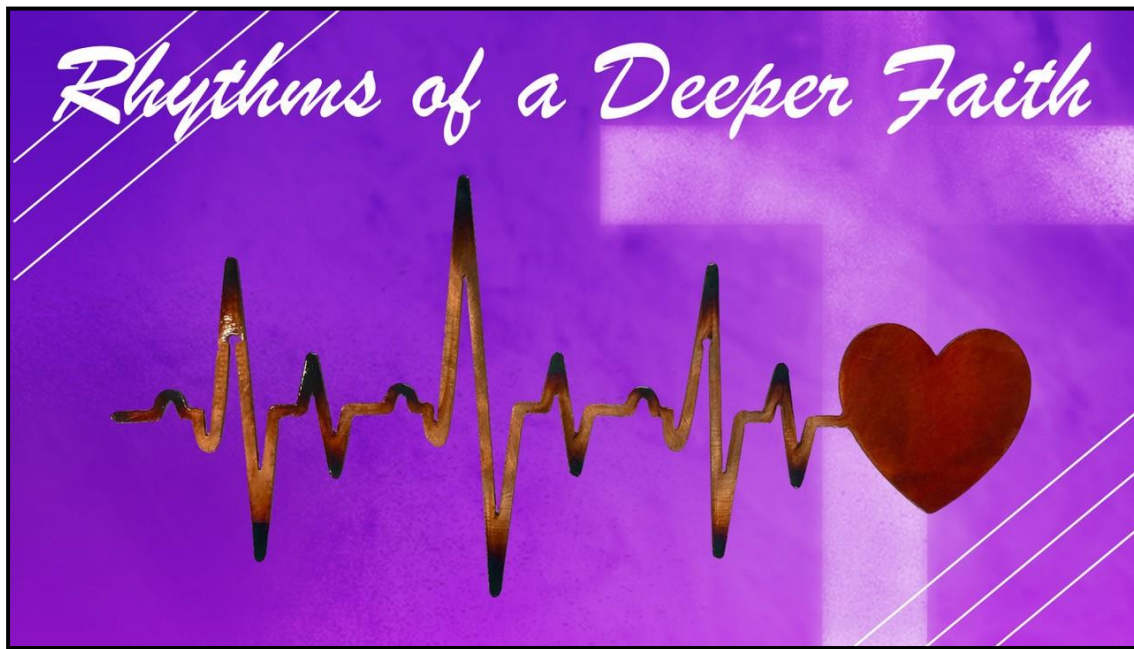

Welcome to Bethel Church today. Whether in person, or online, we hope your time spent worshipping the Lord will be a blessing. Psalm 95 calls out to God’s people: Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord, let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation! Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song. For the Lord is the great God, the great King above all “gods”. Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker, for he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. We encourage you to give God the glory this morning in worship and song!

Our Lenten Sermon Series: "Rhythms of a Deeper Faith" explores things like Prayer, Reading Scripture, Fasting, Confession, Worship, Silence, and Gratitude as those biblical practices that can bring us closer to God. On this second Sunday in Lent we reflect on “Reading Scripture”. What is it about reading the Bible that is so important? Is there a way to read that helps us hear God’s voice more effectively? During the 5 p.m. Worship Service, we will be continuing with Mark’s gospel, Mark 8:1-21, as we read about yet another feeding miracle. Another feeding miracle? Yes. With yeast, signs and bread being all a part of the discussion.

Next week, Lord willing, we will be celebrating the sacrament of the **Lord’s Supper** during the morning worship service. May God use this gift he has given through his Son Jesus to affirm our faith and draw us closer to him. We will be using pre-packaged communion cups that you will be able to pick up prior to entering the sanctuary.

Next week Sunday we hope you will join us for a Combined **MISSION EMPHASIS SERVICE at 5:00 pm here at Bethel**. The focus will be on the work of Renee (Holwerda) and Tim Aupperlee and their work with Barnabas International in partnership with Resonate Global Ministries. The message will be given by Rev. Tim Holwerda, currently serving in Byron Center, MI. The Aupperlees and Rev. Holwerda have served in overseas missions. Renee and Tim attended Bethel when they were younger. The offering will be for Barnabas International for Aupperlee support.

In light of worshipping together with the social distancing restrictions still in place, we want to share some of the guidelines we are continuing to follow:

- There will be no greeters at church during this time.
- Usher will be present to help seat. Every other pew has been “cordoned off” by the placement of hymnals and Bibles on the seats.
- We ask and encourage that people adhere to CDC guidelines in terms of washing their hands, not touching their faces, and maintaining social distancing while we are together.
- We encourage if you are sick, have a temperature, or believe you are an “at risk” person, that you stay home and take advantage of the on-line service opportunity.
- We strongly encourage the use of face coverings as you enter and exit the building, however you will not be turned away should you find it difficult to do so. Our number one concern is the health of our church family as we gather in worship, loving our God as well as our neighbor.
- Nursery is available for the am service only.
- Bathrooms are available. Again, please follow CDC guidelines about good hygiene.
- No offering plate will be passed during the worship service, but offering boxes will be available by the sanctuary doors in which you may place your gifts. Again, online giving continues to remain an option.
- Following the service, there will be no coffee or snack time. You are encouraged to NOT linger in the narthex, wear a mask and follow social distancing guidelines
