There are several important aspects of worship mentioned in Psalm 96.

"Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness." v. 9

- 1. The proclamation of the Word "proclaim his salvation day after day" v. 2
- 2. Prayer "ascribe to the Lord glory and strength" v. 7
- 3. Praise "sing to the Lord, praise his name" v. 1
- 4. Giving -- "bring an offering and come into his courts" v. 8

# Romans 8:26-27 SOMEBODY'S PRAYING FOR YOU 5PM Outline

- A. Human Weakness -- "we do not know what to pray for"
  - 1. We do not always pray in the right way. Our prayers often lack ...
    - a. sincerity
    - b. humility
    - c. faith
- 2. We do not always know what our true needs are.
- B. Divine Intercession -- "the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans"
- C. Divine Approval-- "he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God."
