TODAY the <u>special offering</u> will be for **ANEW MINISTRIES** which supports the TMC program (Teen Mother Choices). Here is an update on the TMC ministry:

TMC seeks to support single moms by helping them to achieve personal, financial, physical, educational, & spiritual goals in order to help them work toward independence which benefits both her and her child(ren). There are 3 TMC ministries in our area at this time; Cedar Lake, Munster (which will start in September) & DeMotte.

The DeMotte program is based at Immanuel United Reformed Church where Stacey Tolkamp is the program director. There are 2 single moms right now going through the program which started in February and there is room for more. Each mom is paired with a mentor and they meet together once a week as a group. Meetings consist of eating a meal together provided by a church volunteer and afterwards learning a life skill, meeting with a financial advisor, setting goals, or participating in a discussion. Nursery care is also provided for their children. At present, each mom is on their way to getting their GED which will open up more opportunities for employment in the future.
