

The Bethel Council wants to thank all members who attended the Congregational Meeting this past Tuesday. Also, a thank you to those who submitted Absentee ballots on the issues. This was a very important meeting for Bethel as discussions and voting took place to guide us through the coming year as the Lord leads. All three of the issues upon which we were asked to vote (2024 Budget, Pastoral call to Jeremy Oosterhouse, and Discontinuing the Sunday afternoon services - emphasizing Small Group meetings during the week) passed by significant numbers. The Official Letter of Call to Jeremy is now being completed, and a personal phone conversation has already taken place with him to inform him of the vote. We asked for the Lord's leading in all these matters, and it is now prudent upon each one of us that we follow His leading by personal involvement in Serving, Building, Leading, and Praying. It means ACTION on our part!
